Local Projects: The OLEFINS II



Fluor Corp. was appointed as the EPC for the OLEFINS II that is owned by a venture of [Dow Chemical Company](#) and [Petrochemical Industries Co](#) to provide engineering, procurement and construction management services for the utilities and infrastructure portion of the major petrochemical project in Kuwait.

This scope is in addition to the program management contract to perform overall management consultancy and front-end engineering.

The billion-plus dollar, integrated petrochemical complex is located approximately 25 miles South of Kuwait City in Shuaiba. The completed facility

will double the capacity at the existing olefins complex.

Ground-breaking occurred in March 2005, with completion of the complex expected in the second quarter of 2008. The project is now 70% complete in terms of construction.
